

Emergency Response Policy

August 2016



It is recommended that each WADCC Club establishes an emergency plan that will assist in managing any accident, injury or emergency that occurs on its club premises or grounds.

A WADCC Club must meet the following requirements:

- Display its emergency plan in its clubrooms, including contact details for doctor/medical centre, hospital emergency department, ambulance, fire brigade and police.
- Have a current Certificate of Currency for the Club's Public and Products Liability Insurance as part of the JLT National Club Risk Protection Programme.
- Have at least one first aid trained officer present during the hours of play.
- Have the captain or senior player from each team with appropriate first aid training.
- Have a fully stocked and up to date First Aid kit, ice packs and stretcher at each venue.
- Have the following information sheets available: National Club Risk Protection Programme Summary, General Public and Products Liability Summary, Personal Injury Summary, Club Management Liability Summary, How to Make a Claim Fact Sheet, Risk Management Information Sheet, Game Day Checklist Case Study, Medicare vs Risk Protection, Inspections and Checklists and Cricket Australia's Playing Policies and Guidelines.
- Have the following policy documents available: Personal Injury Policy Wording, Personal Injury Policy Schedule, Club Management Liability Policy Schedule, Club Management Liability Policy Wording, Combined General & Products Liability Policy Wording (Primary) and Combined General & Products Liability Policy Wording (Excess).
- Have the following forms available: JLT Sport Personal Injury Claim Form, Game Day Checklist, General Liability Claim Form and Loss of Income Optional Upgrade Form.
